

#### **MALTING FARM**

We may be a tad biased, but we think our little corner of North East Essex boasts some of the most beautiful countryside that the British Isles has to offer! Our rich farmland and local countryside is crisscrossed with meandering waterways and footpaths, which offers plenty of walking, cycling and boating fun for those of all ages.

Malting Farm Nature Trail: Pick up a free map in your accommodation or from reception and then hit our fun farm nature trail that will take you around the site.

**Fire Pit & Communal Dining Area:** make the most of your evenings round the communal fire pit and dining area at the site.

**Fishing:** Our stunning reservoir is regularly re-stocked with fish and we welcome you to bring your fishing equipment with you when you come to stay. Fishing is free on the reservoir, but please be aware that paddleboarders and swimmers take priority (even if you are already there fishing). If you fancy casting a line during your stay, please make sure you've packed your own equipment and bait.

Paddle Boarding: If you're looking for a fun, energetic activity right on your doorstep; why not try your hand at a spot of paddleboarding on our beautiful, water tested reservoir? You can pre-book book your life-jackets and paddleboards for a 2-hour slot when you make your booking or on arrival, but please note that hire is on a first come, first serve basis. We also ask you to ensure children are supervised on and around the reservoir at all times, that life jackets MUST be worn on the Paddleboards and that paddleboards are not taken off of the farm.

**Egg Collecting:** Help care for and collect eggs daily from our cheerful choocks in the communal chicken coop.

Cycling: If you'd like to explore our local countryside on two wheels, we have a small range of both children's and adult's bikes available to hire from reception. Our bikes are available to hire for a morning or afternoon sessions, or for those wanting to go a little further afield, you can hire them for a full day. To reserve your bikes, simply add them to your booking, or alternatively book them on arrival. Please note that you must bring your own helmets and that bike hire is available on a first come, first serve basis

Brook Meadow Menagerie: If you're keen to get up close and personal to some farm animals or some small furry and feathered friends; then take a trip to Brook Meadow Farm Menagerie. Within walking distance of your cabin, it's a great experience on our doorstep. To visit, simply walk up to the top of the meadow from the front your cabin!

Pony & Unicorn Days: If you have a pony mad person in your group; arrange a fabulously fun unicorn party or a farm pony pamper session. # LOCAL BEACHES



We have a rich and varied coastline for you to explore; so grab your bucket and spade and head to our stunning beaches for a fabulous day out. From the sandy expanses and beach huts at Frinton-on-the-Sea, to fossil hunting and dramatic views at Walton-on-the-Naze; we've got a beach to match your mood!

Frinton-on-the-Sea (9.9 miles – 19 mins): This sandy beach crowned with its colourful line of beach huts is perfect for those looking to build sand castles and dip their toes in the water. Easy to get to, with lots of facilities it's great for families.

Clacton-on-Sea (9.4 miles – 16 mins): Famous for its big sandy beach and its beautiful pier, Clacton offers a variety of seaside amusements as well as a yearly air show in August.

Walton-on-the-Naze (10.5 miles – 20 mins): The big open, sandy beaches here are beautiful and accessible. You can also book a boat trip around the beautiful nature reserve to spot the local common and grey seals.

**Brightlingsea (8.9 miles – 19 mins):** At the mouth to the River Stour this sandy beach is marked by Batemans Tower. Its accessible coast is great for sailing and crabbing!

Fossil Hunting at The Naze (12.1 – 26 mins):

You'll find this fascinating Essex Wildlife Trust beach at the top of Walton-on-the-Naze. The dramatic cliffs that tower above the beach are home to an abundance of flora and fauna. While the beach itself offers the enticing chance of finding your own fossil. Though access is down some steps, the visitors centre and café offer great facilities for families...ensure you check the tides, low tide is best for rock-pool hunting and fossil collecting.

Harwich (9.8 miles – 13 mins): Start your trip by hopping aboard a boat at the Ha'penny pier to take a closer look at the growing population of seals and bird life, and then warm up with delicious Fish & Chips at The Pier.

Mersea Island (16.5 miles – 28 mins): Famous for its oysters and delicious seafood, Mersea Island is a great place to try your hand at crabbing or sailing...but don't forget to check the tide times!



#### PLACES TO VISIT

Though firmly based in the countryside, the town of Colchester along with a huge variety of attractions are within easy reach of Malting Farm. From iconic historical properties and artistic landscapes to wild days at the zoo; there's something for every member of the family. So make the most of your visit and explore some of Essex & Suffolk's wonderful attractions.

Colchester & Colchester Castle (10.7 miles- 19 mins): Colchester is England's oldest recorded town and is stepped in history. Whilst there visit the wonderfully interactive Colchester Castle that will help you explore our colourful history. From Boudicca's famous burning to our more recent past, there's plenty of exhibits to keep you entertained.

Colchester Zoo (15.8 miles – 20 mins): This world renowned zoo is a great day out for animal lovers of all ages. On top of the amazing animal exhibits, you'll also find interactive areas, animal feeding, keeper talks, activities, plenty of places to eat and a train!

Beth Chatto Gardens (4.6 miles – 11 mins): Take a walk through the beautifully designed and maintained gardens, before stopping for a delicious slice of cake at their horticulturally Inspired café.

Flatford (5.2 miles -21 mins): This National Trust property allows you to see the place where John Constable famously painted The Haywain. The museum, tea rooms, RSPB garden, boat hire and accessible walks along the river offer a fun packed day out.

Jimmy's Farm (13.9 miles -26 mins): A little further afield, but a great day out for all the family. Meet a huge range of animals, build dens and of course sample their award winning sausages.

Constable Country & Dedham Vale (7.2 miles – 20 mins): Made famous by John Constables paintings; Constable Country covers most of Flatford and the Dedham Vale. In Dedham you can enjoy gentle riverside walks, quintessential cream tea's, galleries and boating on the river.

Manningtree & Mistley (4.7 miles -11 mins):
Delightfully situated on the Stour Estuary,
Manningtree is the Uk's smallest town. This
historic tidal town and its neighbour Mistley are
synonymous with Matthew Hopkins (the
infamous Witch Finder General!), but you're more
likely to find good food, plenty of wild fowl and
stunning views across the river to
Suffolk than any witch trials.

**Kentwell Hall (27.2 miles – 44 mins):** This stunning moated Tudor house hosts fabulous re-enactments and events that both inspire and educate. The beautiful house and gardens are well worth a visit, as is their tea room!

**Sutton Hoo (34.4 miles- 42 mins):** Visit this fascinating Anglo Saxon site made famous by the recent hit film "The Dig". Explore the interactive visitor centre and stroll round the iconic mounds in Basil Browns footsteps.



#### **ACTIVITIES**

## **ART & CULTURE**

Our varied landscape and rich history has inspired some renowned artists and performers over the years. Colchester offers a wide range of gallery's, studios and theatre. But a little further afield you'll be able to discover more about our local famous artists. In Dedham you can to explore Munnings effortless style, before you walk up to Flatford to experience Constables famous Haywain.





Alfred Munnings & Dedham Vale (7.2 miles – 20 mins): The Munnings Museum offers you a unique opportunity to view this fabulous artist's work in his own home before you explore Dedham and the surrounding area.

John Constable and Flatford (5.2 miles -21 mins): Visit the location where the Haywain was painted and immerse yourself in the landscape that shaped this romantic artist's paintings. This National Trust property hosts a museum, café, boat hire and RSPB garden.

Theatres in Colchester (9.5 miles – 19 mins): You'll find regular live theatre performances at the Mercury Theatre, as well as a variety of other venues offering comedy and open air drama.

**Curzon Cinema (8.6 miles – 17 mins):** This small cinema offers a more grown-up space to watch box office hits and more fringe cinematic titles from.

**Firstsite (8.6 miles – 17 mins):** Located in the heart of Colchester, this space hosts a range of different exhibitions, workshops and performances.
